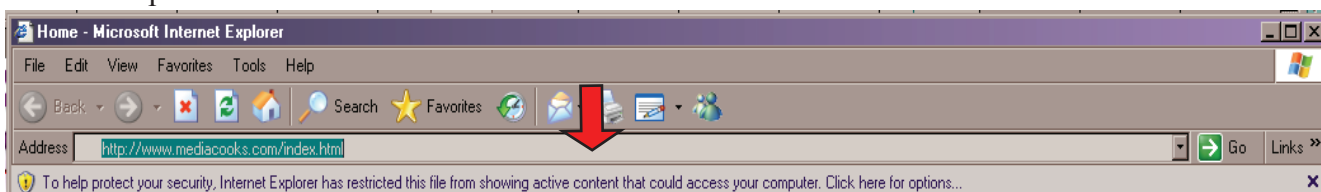


Microsoft Internet Security and how it affects your enjoyment of our web site

Our web site uses java scripts to allow for better navigation and for other advanced features. These are common scripts and will not harm your computer or transmit any personally identifiable information, unless agreed to. Although we applaud Microsoft's attempts to provide better security for the end user, it can hinder your enjoyment of our web site and others. Most of our web site will operate without allowing the blocked content but it may hinder your enjoyment of the web site. If you want to know how to allow blocked content on your Windows system please read on.

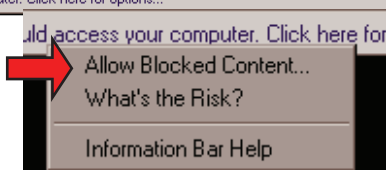
How To allow Blocked Content

The quickest way to allow blocked content is to click on the bar that pops up under the address bar in Internet Explorer.

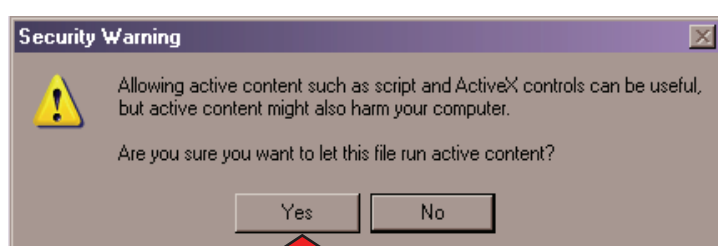


After you click a small menu will pop up.

Click on Allow Blocked Content.



A Security Warning Message will Pop up. Click on the Yes Button.



You will have to do this on every page that uses active content.

How To Set Your Internet Security to fully enjoy our web site

Click on the Security Center Icon in the system tray to open the Security Center Window. (Usually the bottom right corner of the screen) Or select Security Center from the Control Panel (Start - Settings - Control Panel)

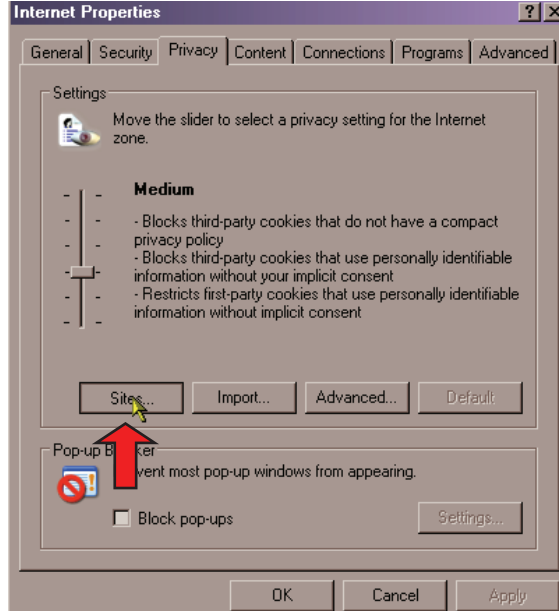
The Security Center Window should pop up.

Double Click on the Internet Options near the bottom of the window.

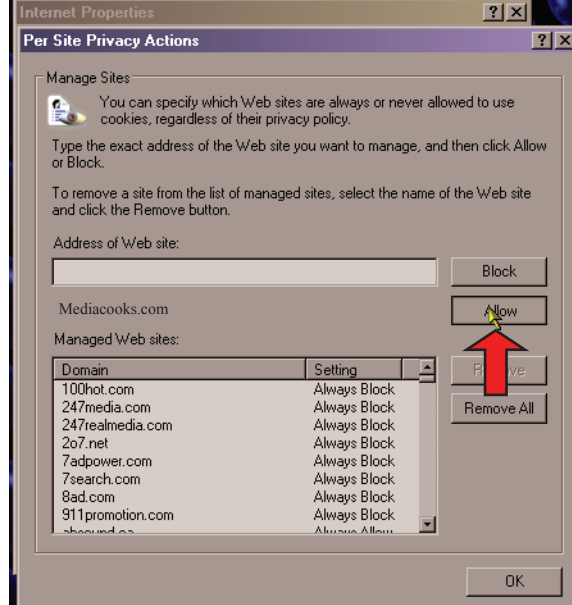
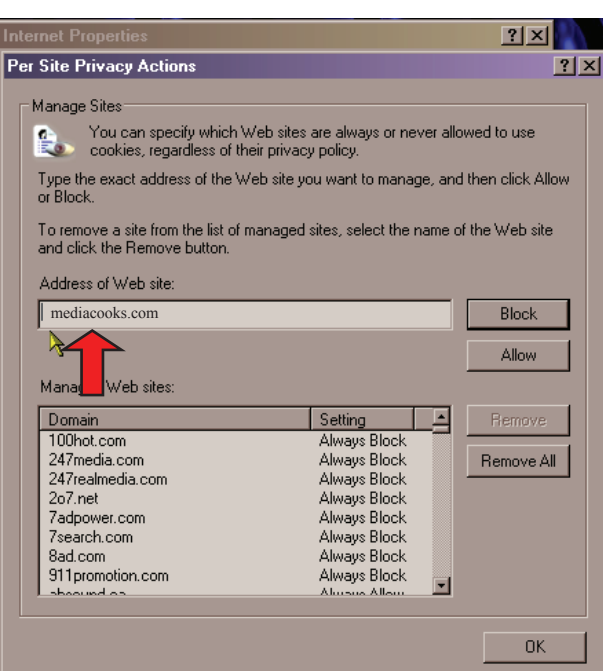


The Internet Properties dialog should open. Click on the Privacy tab.

Once the Privacy Tab has opened, click on the Sites button.

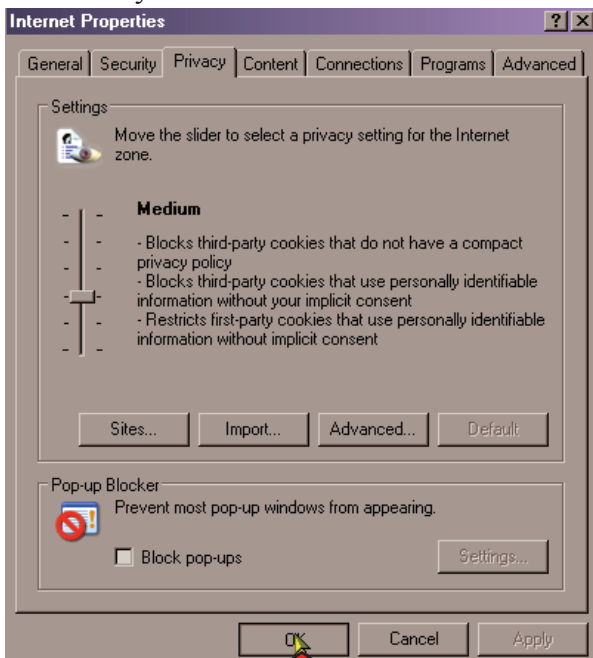
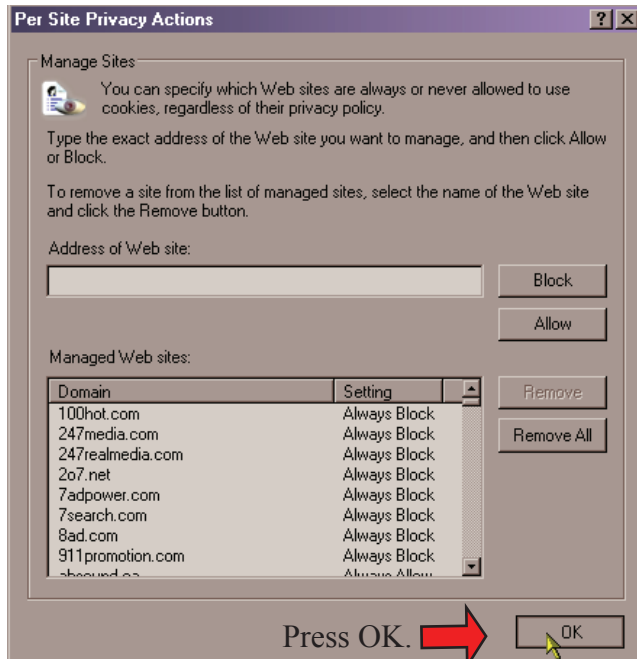


The Site Privacy Window should open. To add Media Cooks to your trusted sites type mediacoops.com where it says Address of Web site.



At this point you can enter other web site addresses to allow or block by repeating the step above, with the new site address. If you do not want to add more sites Press OK.

You will return to the Privacy Tab. Since we are done you can click on the OK button.

Click on the Close button [x] on the title bar to exit the Security Center.
